About Our Host Hotel

The Publick House Historic Inn in Sturbridge, Massachusetts was established in 1771 and maintains its 18th century ambiance while providing 21st-century comforts. Their group rate for the rooms starts at \$95 and go up from there. The Publick House Historic Inn has 17 guest rooms in this historical setting are decorated with period antiques or reproductions. Chamberlain House, which was once an old farmhouse that offered overnight accommodations, was reopened in 2016 after renovating the farmhouse portion and adding new construction that now features 20 guest rooms, including 12 suites. These rooms are designed for those staying in the area on business or spending the weekend with friends and family.

The Country Motor Lodge, just a short walk from the Main Inn and nestled in an apple orchard, opened in 1960. The Country Motor Lodge offers 63 standard hotel rooms and overlooks the Publick House and is connected via a private walkway and road to the Inn. All guest rooms are non-smoking. Pet-friendly rooms are available upon request.

The Tillyer House is their newest addition, which opened in October 2018. Located to the right of the Publick House Historic Inn, offering 28 overnight rooms, a fitness room, spa and large sitting areas in the lobby and throughout for guests to gather and relax while enjoying their accommodations. Each room offers two queen-size beds, a refrigerator, an in-room safe and a walk-in shower (some rooms also have standard bathtubs). Tour of a privately owned local Model A Ford Museum that is jam-packed with memorabilia, displays and cars. The museum takes about 1 - 1 1/2 hours to view and can accommodate approximately 20 - 25 attendees at a time. If necessary, we can split this into 2 tours. It is about a 25-minute ride from the hotel with lots of parking on the grass behind the museum. We will leave the hotel at **12:30 PM** arrive at approximately 1:00 PM. Please book early. There is no charge, however, we suggest a \$5 donation per person be left at the museum donation box.

Friday, July 1: 10:30 AM Essex Steam Train and Riverboat Cruise:

The Essex Steam Train and Riverboat is a 2 1/2 hour journey which begins at the historic 1892 Essex Station for a 1-hour, 12-mile, narrated round trip into the heart of the unspoiled Connecticut River Valley. The steam locomotive pulls vintage coaches through the quintessential New England towns of Deep River and Chester. A natural highlight is the undeveloped Selden Neck State Park, accessible only by boat. The Essex Steam Train offers unique access to several coves and preserves, immersing passengers in an onboard eco-excursion. The train travels near the tidal wetlands of Pratt Cove and Chester Creek with bountiful, natural habitats for birds including Cormorants, Ducks, Swans, Greenland Geese, Blue Heron, Egrets and Red-winged Blackbirds. At Deep River Landing, passengers are escorted onto the Becky Thatcher riverboat for a 1 1/4 hour cruise along the Connecticut River. The visual serenity of the river valley is on full display from Becky's multiple decks. The deep water, coves, inlets, marshes, wildlife and rocky shoreline are, all at once, simply breathtaking! Just as impressive are the historic sites, including Gillette Castle, Goodspeed Opera House and the Haddam Swing Bridge. Upon Becky's return to Deep River Landing, the steam train welcomes passengers for the return trip back to Essex Station.

We will leave Host Hotel at **10:30 AM** on the bus. We will arrive at 12:15 PM for the 12:30 PM Essex Steam Train and River Boat Cruise. We will board the bus at 3:00 PM to return to the hotel. **Maximum seating on the bus is 56 people so please book early.** Time is subject to change. https://essexsteamtrain.com/

- Pasta Primavera with Roasted Garden Vegetables in a Light Cream Sauce


