

#### 2023 PROFESSIONAL CAR SOCIETY 46th INTERNATIONAL MEET

## **SCHEDULE OF PLANNED EVENTS** (all tours are with you driving your own vehicle)

Tuesday, Aug. 8: Kreider Farms Tour. Depart at 12:30 PM. 37 miles. Cost: \$14.00 per person (kreiderfarms.com)

Experience the sights, sounds and smells of a real, working dairy farm on the Kreider Farms tour. This 90 minute tour features a high-tech view of farming, including a drive down the middle of our "Cow Palace" barn and a bird's eye view of the milking carousel where we milk 1700 cows, 3 times every day. Tour is limited to 56 people.

Tuesday, Aug. 8: Dinner at the Yoder's Country Market. Meet there at 5:00 PM 10 miles from host hotel. Cost: \$27.00 per person. (yoderscountrymarket.com/restaurant)

Wednesday, Aug. 9: Boyertown Museum of Historic Vehicles. Depart at 12:30 PM. 27 miles. Cost: \$10 per person. (boyertownmuseum.org)

See vehicles of all types: gasoline, electric and horse-drawn, including carriages, wagons, and sleighs. You will see 'high wheelers' and "safety bicycles," vehicle builder's tools and local historic roadside architecture. The museum is housed in the former home of the Boyertown Auto Body Works, which had continuous operations on this site from 1872 – 1990 and retains the factory setting, making it a unique and interesting setting for the vehicles. Lunch is available at "The Grind" restaurant located at 45 S. Reading Ave. The restaurant is within walking distance of the museum.

After visiting the museum, you can drive to Eastwood Auto Restoration Supplies (eastwood.com) and/or the Pottstown Carousel (carouselatpottstown.org) before heading back to the host hotel.

**Friday, August 11**: Today, you are on your own. We will have some suggestions as to various local attractions or if you are interested in a scenic tour, we have mapped out a tour of the local covered bridges.

Friday evening, August 11: 8:00 PM - Membership Meeting at the host hotel. This meeting is open to all PCS members.

**9:00 AM - 10:00 AM**: Judging School Meeting: All interested members please attend this meeting to learn about our judging and please consider becoming a judge.

**9:00 AM**: Placement of cars in the indoor showroom. Once the indoor showroom is full, cars will be displayed on the outside showfield. Indoor placement will be determined by the earliest postmark of registrations. Indoor parking is estimated to accommodate 30 vehicles.

Reminder: All show vehicles must have a wheel chock in its correct placement and have a minimum 2.5-lb fire extinguisher.

**10:30 AM**: Judging of all cars begins. Indoor cars are to be moved from the building to the outdoor showfield by 4:30 PM

**6:00 PM**: Happy Hour with a cash bar just outside of the host hotel dining room.

**7:00 PM**: Dinner in the host hotel dining room. Awards will be presented afterward and following that, we will hold our traditional light show on the show field. We are presently working to get permission to include sirens.
